Note 6. Advanced Business Elective & Advanced Finance Elective

Advanced business electives include any Junior (3000 level) or Senior (4000 level) course with a prefix of ACC, BIS, ECO, FIN, GBU, MGM, or MKT. **Advisor input is strongly recommended.**

Note 7. General BBA Requirements

- · Remedial courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better and before any upper division courses can be taken.
- Students must have completed a minimum of 120 semester hours. <u>Note</u>: Remedial courses do not count in this total.
- After earning 40 credit hours, with a minimum GPA of 2.5, students are required to apply to the School of Business (see catalog for details).
- In addition to the Liberal Arts Core, BBA candidates must complete a minimum of 50 semester hours of business courses with a grade of "C" or higher. No more than 7 hours of "D" may be earned in the Liberal Arts Core.
- Students who enter Henderson on the 2006-2008 catalog or later must complete at least one writing intensive (WI) courses.
- Students may not graduate with a grade of "D" or lower in any course used to meet the requirements listed in the major field of study or area
 of concentration.
- Students must complete at least 42 junior-senior hours (course numbers beginning with a 3 or 4.)
- Free electives should be chosen to enrich the student's college program and may include business courses. Advisor input is important in selecting
 these courses.
- No freshman (1000 level) course may be taken for credit after the student has completed 90 hours (unless it is a required course).
- Business majors may, but are <u>not</u> required to, minor in any of several non-business fields.
