29 hours of education courses (EDU, SPE) and one methods course, BIO 3423 Teaching Methods for Biological Sciences, also are required. Because of the requirement of these additional 32 hours, a minor is not required for the teacher licensure track. For the nom-western culture elective, biology majors seeking teacher licensure should consider EDU 4543 Exploring Perspectives of Linguistically and Culturally Diverse Learners. Satisfactorily completing this course offers additional preparation of teachers. Currently, elementary, special education, and middle level education majors (except language arts) take the course as part of their curriculum.
