Directed Political Science Elective Courses

In addition to the 15 hour core of required political science courses, political science majors must further take 18 hours of directed political science elective courses. Nine of these hours comprise the Subfield requirement. Students must take one three credit course in each of the three subfields of Political Science. The remaining nine credits can be any other Political Science course not already used to satisfy a requirement. For course availability, consult the Social Sciences Department semester course rotation pamphlet and the current Henderson undergraduate catalogue.

Foreign Language Requirement

Students must complete six hours in intermediate level or above of a principal modern foreign language.

Liberal Arts Core Courses

Political Science majors must satisfy the University's liberal arts core requirements, as stipulated in the Henderson undergraduate catalogue.

Minor

Students majoring in political science must also complete the requirements for a minor in another field of study.

NOTE

All Henderson undergraduate students must complete at least one writing intensive (WI) course in the major to be eligible for graduation. Research Methods (PSC 4303) is the writing intensive course for all PSC majors.
