## Educational Examiner Program of Study (15 to 30 hours)

Candidates entering this program must already have a license in K-12 Special Education. As a result, a

transcript evaluation will be required to determine the exact number of courses required to complete the program of study for the Educational Examiner license. This program of study leads to licensure only as an Educational Examiner; it does not lead to a degree.

Beginning FALL 2023, new cohorts will be formed in the FALL semester only and will progress together in order of specific classes. For Example: If you start in Fall 2023 and sit out Spring 2024, you will pick up the rotation in Spring 2025.

## Prerequisite Courses (6 hours)

Prerequisite course requirements may have been completed as part of an undergraduate degree program. Prerequisite courses not taken as part of an undergraduate degree program must be completed at the graduate level. Substitutions for prerequisite courses must be approved by advisor through a transcript evaluation.
