- POSITION:** Curriculum & Instruction Faculty Member, 9-month position starting August 2022.
- DESCRIPTION:** The department is seeking an elementary/middle level education generalist. Primary teaching responsibilities may include combinations of the following: reading methods, reading assessment, elementary methods/practicum, inclusive education, and/or educational technology. The successful applicant is expected to engage in professional development, cross-departmental collaboration, and promotion of the department and the university.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Henderson State University is an Equal Opportunity Employer/Affirmative Action Employer with a significant commitment to the achievement of excellence and diversity among its faculty, staff and students. Candidates must have a master's degree with at least 18 graduate hours in education, reading, special education, or related areas from a regionally accredited institution of higher education. A doctoral degree or ABD status is required for assistant professor rank. All candidates must have a strong record of teaching experience and teacher leadership in grades K-8 and possess or be eligible for a valid teaching license. Excellent verbal and written communication skills together with organizational, human relations and technological skills are expected.
