Staff Athletic Trainer

Position: Henderson State University, an NCAA Division II member of the Great American Conference, is accepting applications for the position of staff athletic trainer.

Job Description: The staff athletic trainer will report to the Assistant Athletics Director for Sports Medicine for all matters pertaining to Henderson State University athletics. Duties may include, but are not limited to: sports coverage with travel, athletic training room supervision, teaching, clinical education instruction, as well as campus and community service. This position will require work outside of regular business hours including evenings and weekend. This position will require travel.

Qualifications: Henderson State University is an Equal Opportunity Employer/Affirmative Action Employer with a significant commitment to the achievement of excellence and diversity among its faculty, staff, and students. In pursuit of this commitment, NATA certification, eligibility for Arkansas Athletic Training licensure and a master's degree are required.
