Reddie Virtual STEAM Academy via The STEM Center at Henderson State

Grant-Funded Summer/Fall STEAM Fellow (2 positions)

Job Description: The two Reddie Virtual STEAM Academy (RVSA) Fellows at the STEM Center at Henderson State University are grant funded part-time positions, beginning immediately and extending through December 31, 2021. Working 24 hours per week, each RVSA Fellow assists in creating, implementing, and delivering digital coursework through RVSA and collaborates with the co-directors to provide support to RVSA participants and Partners in Education districts through coursework, professional development, and site visits. The successful candidates are expected to learn and navigate the tools necessary for the existing RVSA structure, effectively develop, support, and provide instruction supporting the grant goals and objectives. The RVSA Fellows collaborate with the STEM Center staff, Teachers College, and other university faculty and staff.

Qualifications: Henderson State University is an Equal Opportunity/Affirmative Action Employer with a significant commitment to the achievement of excellence and diversity among its faculty, staff, and students. In pursuit of this commitment, candidates will possess a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution. A valid Arkansas driver's license and liability insurance are required. Eligibility for or progress towards teaching license is desired along with experience working with adolescents. The successful candidates will have the ability to collaborate with diverse populations. Excellent verbal and written communication skills along with interpersonal, organizational, and technological skills are expected. Experience with a learning management system such as Canvas, Blackboard, or Google Classroom preferred. Candidates should possess experience with and a desire to learn a variety of technologies.

Salary: The fellowship amount ranges from \$14,000 to \$16,000. Commensurate with qualifications and experience.

University: Henderson State University is located in Arkadelphia, Arkansas, a charming, family-centered community of 11,000 residents situated one hour south of Little Rock, Arkansas on Interstate 30. Nestled in the foothills of the Ouachita Mountains, the community is home to two universities, a strong public school system, a thriving medical community, two recreational rivers, the iconic Lake DeGray, and is approximately 30 miles from historic Hot Springs National Park, one of the great American treasures.
